I. ABOUT THE JOURNAL

The Journal accepts works and researches from diverse areas of life which include Anthropology, History, Political Science, Sociology, Language, Economics, Psychology, Criminology, Linguistics, Law, Cultural Studies, Gender Studies, Diaspora, Migration Studies, Race and Ethics, religion, Environment and any other contemporary concerns. It welcomes theoretical, methodological, quantitative and qualitative ideas from all the areas under the realm of Social Sciences. The Journal aims to promote an evocative platform for the latest but relevant emerging research and learning in different arenas of academia and research. It aims to contribute to the on-going debates, putting end to various dilemmas, etc. Additionally, it includes all those learnings which are associated with society, human beings, communities, human psyche, and relationship between individuals and with their societies. The scope of this journal is to establish conducive environment for discourses in the mentioned areas and its affect on society in order to devise better strategies and policies for living.

II. IMPORTANT DATE

The last date for **submission of Paper** is **May 1st, 2026**. Selection of entries shall be based on blind peer review. Queries about submission of papers and related matters may be directed to **jss@hpnl.u.ac.in** email. Submissions will be evaluated on academic relevance, augmentation and methodology to uphold the highest research and ethical standards.

III. CATEGORIES OF SUBMISSION

Categories for submission Contribution may be made in the form of Research Papers / Article, Notes & Comments and Book Review. The contribution, in given category, should be comprehensive and in-depth analysis of contemporary social, political, economic issues.

The following word limits should be observed:

- **ARTICLES (6000-10000 words)**
- **ESSAYS AND COMMENTS (4000-6000 words)**
- **BOOK REVIEW (3000-4000words) (Contribution under this Category is required to be made along with the new hard copy of the Book).**

IV. SUBMISSION GUIDLINES

1. **Theme:** There is no specific or particular theme(s) or topic(s) for the Volume. All submissions, relating to Anthropology, History, Political Science, Sociology, Language, Economics, Psychology, Criminology, Linguistics, Law, Cultural Studies, Gender Studies, Diaspora, Migration Studies, Race and Ethics, religion, Environment and any other contemporary concerns are welcomed.
2. **Submission in electronic form:** All contributions have to be submitted in electronic form. The manuscript should be typed in MS Office double spaced, with a left margin of one and half inches, and sent to jss@hpnlu.ac.in
3. **Abstract:** Abstract of the paper in 250-300 words should be sent along with the electronic submissions as one MS Word file.
4. **Covering Letter:** Author(s) must send a covering letter mentioning the title of the paper, name, designation, and details of the author(s) as well as institutional affiliation. **The author(s) are compulsorily required to make a solemn declaration about the originality of the manuscript and that the same has not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere. Manuscripts containing any material published elsewhere, in whole or in part, shall be liable to rejection at any stage of the review or publication process.**

5. Communication of Acceptance: The decision on the acceptance of the paper for publication will be that of the Editorial Board, which shall be final. The communication shall be made electronically. The Editorial Board reserves the right of publication, and a manuscript may be rejected from publication in the final stage(s).

6. Citation: Author(s) have the option to choose from the latest editions of Bluebook, APA, MLA and Chicago styles of citations. Only one style of citation must be followed throughout the paper.

7. Plagiarism Report: A plagiarism report should be attached, along with an AI Report. A maximum of 10% of Plagiarism is allowed excluding footnotes.

(Note: AI-generated content is not permitted. Non-compliance with the suggested modifications within the given time will lead to rejection at the final stage.)

V. STYLE REQUIREMENTS

1. Strictly adhere to the latest citation as per the requirement of the discipline it belongs to.
2. Lengthy Quotations discouraged: Author(s) should avoid long quotations and keep it at minimum wherever necessary with full and proper acknowledgement.
3. Websites: Only authoritative and authentic websites may be cited. References to internet sources, such as Wikipedia, blogs, commercial websites, etc., are not acceptable.

VI. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The manuscripts should be the original work of the contributor and not a compilation of pre-existing works on the subject. It should not amount to the violation of others' copyright. The contributor has to give a declaration as to originality of the work.
2. The copyright in all articles, published in the Volume, shall vest in the owner of HPNLU, Shimla.
3. The views adopted from other sources and others' work must be quoted and sufficiently acknowledged.
4. Paraphrasing another author's work shall not be considered as original work. The source has to be acknowledged.
5. The Contributor has to cover the risk of being sued for copyright, defamation or contempt and shall be liable to suffer the losses if caused by violating copyright.
