NOTICE

**(B.A./B.B.A. LL.B. FYIC Academic Session: 2019-2020) 2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th
Semesters End-Term Examinations, 29 September- to 09 October 2020.**


The requirements of holding End-Term Examinations are prescribed in the UGC Revised Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar for the Universities in view of COVID-19 Pandemic dated 6th July, 2020, Letter No: D.O.No.F.1-1/2020(Secy), UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar in view of COVID-19 Pandemic dated 29th April, 2020, Letter No:D.O.No.F.1-1/2020(Secy) and Press Release of Bar Council of India dated 09.06.2020. The UGC revised guidelines dated 6th July, 2020 as well as 29th April, 2020 requires that the End-Semester Examinations has to be conducted in Online mode while observing the social distancing norms in view of the COVID-19 Pandemic. The UGC guidelines further requires that the Examinations are to be completed by the month of September, 2020.

The Bar Council of India press release dated 9.06.2020, Paragraph 4, mandates for promoting students to Higher years of next semester but it is mandatory requirement of the Council that the End-Term Examinations (excluding reappear examinations) shall be conducted for the Year or Semester from which students have been promoted.

In view of the above requirements, on the recommendations of the COVID Cell (HPNLU), the Academic Council has decided that the University has to conduct End-Term Examinations in September-October, 2020. With the permission of the Hon'ble Chancellor, it is hereby notified to all students that the End-Term Examinations of 2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th Semesters (B.A./B.B.A. LL.B. FYIC Academic Session: 2019-2020) shall be conducted during 29 September to 09 October, 2020.

The Brief details of the examinations are given below. Complete instructions and guidelines for students would be issued subsequently.

1. **Mode of Examinations:** Students are required to write Online Examinations Open Book Examinations (OBE), by hand, on Physical Answer Sheets (A4 Size Paper) and submit the scanned copies thereof within the prescribed time period.
2. **Re-appear Examinations:** The Re-appear Examinations shall be held after the declaration of the End-Term Examinations and would be notified later, accordingly.
3. **Preparatory Leave and Remedial Classes:** The preparatory leave of eight days, starting from 20th of September till 28th September, shall be allowed to students. During this period remedial classes shall be conducted by the respective Faculty Members. The detail schedule for remedial classes shall be notified separately.
4. **Examination Form:** The Examination Form already submitted during internal assessment shall be considered for the purpose of the End-Term Examinations.
5. **Question Paper and Weightage of Marks:** The End-Term examination shall be conducted for 50 Marks (each course/paper). The Question Paper shall consist of two sections *i.e.* Section A and Section B. Section A shall consist of 3 short answer type questions and Section B shall contain 3 long answer type questions, covering the entire syllabus. The students are required to answer any two questions, each, from Sections A and B.
6. **Maximum Time Allowed:** Maximum time allowed for writing Examination shall be 2 hours and for scanning and uploading/e-mailing of Answer Sheet, 30 minutes shall be given.
7. **The detailed instructions and guidelines for students, concerning the End-Term Examinations shall be notified subsequently.**
8. **Tentative Date Sheet of the Examinations:** The tentative Date Sheet of the Examinations is enclosed.
