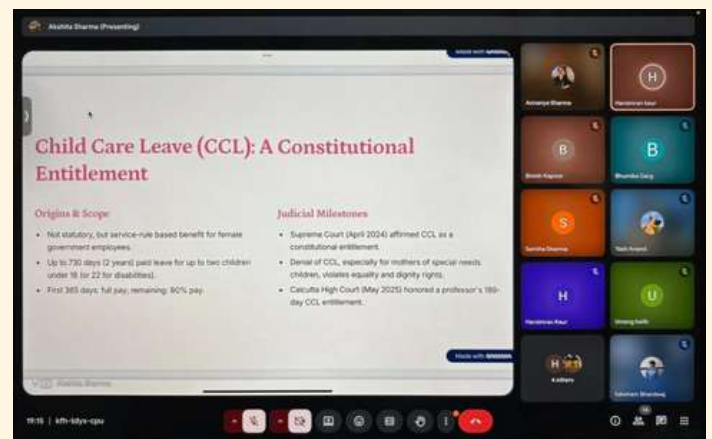

8th - 9th August 2025

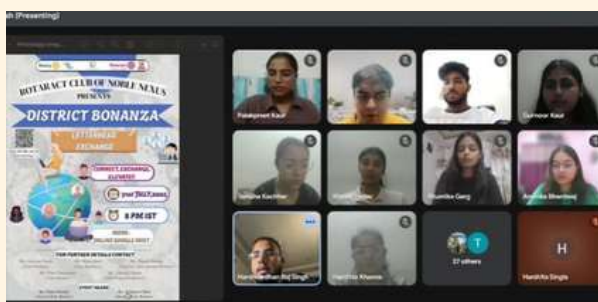
Aligned with July’s theme of “Maternal and Child Health,” the club organized a virtual legal awareness session titled “Cradling Rights, Nurturing Futures: A Legal Lens on Maternity and Child Care.” Open to all individuals interested in gender rights and social justice, the session aimed to enhance understanding of the legal and social safeguards available to mothers and children. Key topics included the Maternity Benefit Act and its 2017 Amendment, crèche facility compliance, judicial recognition of Child Care Leave, the Code on Social Security, 2020, and welfare schemes such as PMMVY (Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana). The session encouraged participants to recognize how legal frameworks contribute to nurturing healthier, fairer, and more equitable futures for women and children.

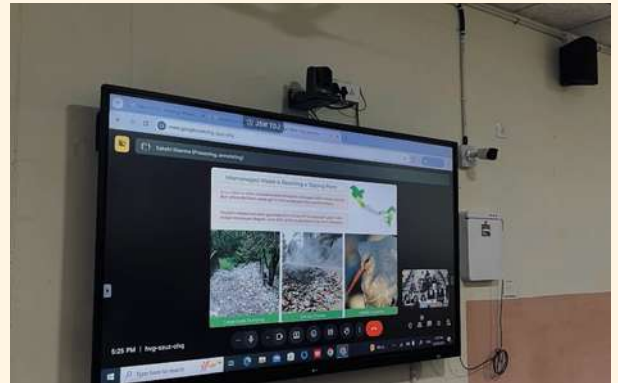

29th October 2025

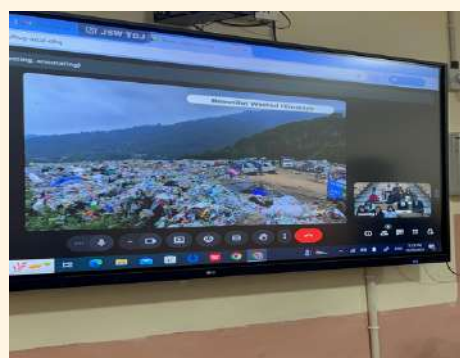

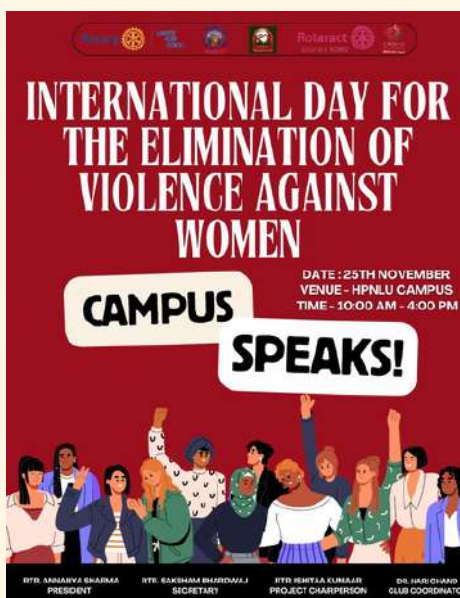
Cervical Cancer Awareness Drive 17th November 2025

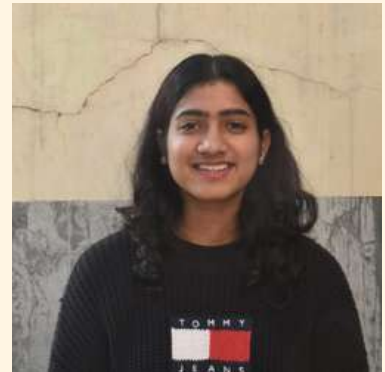

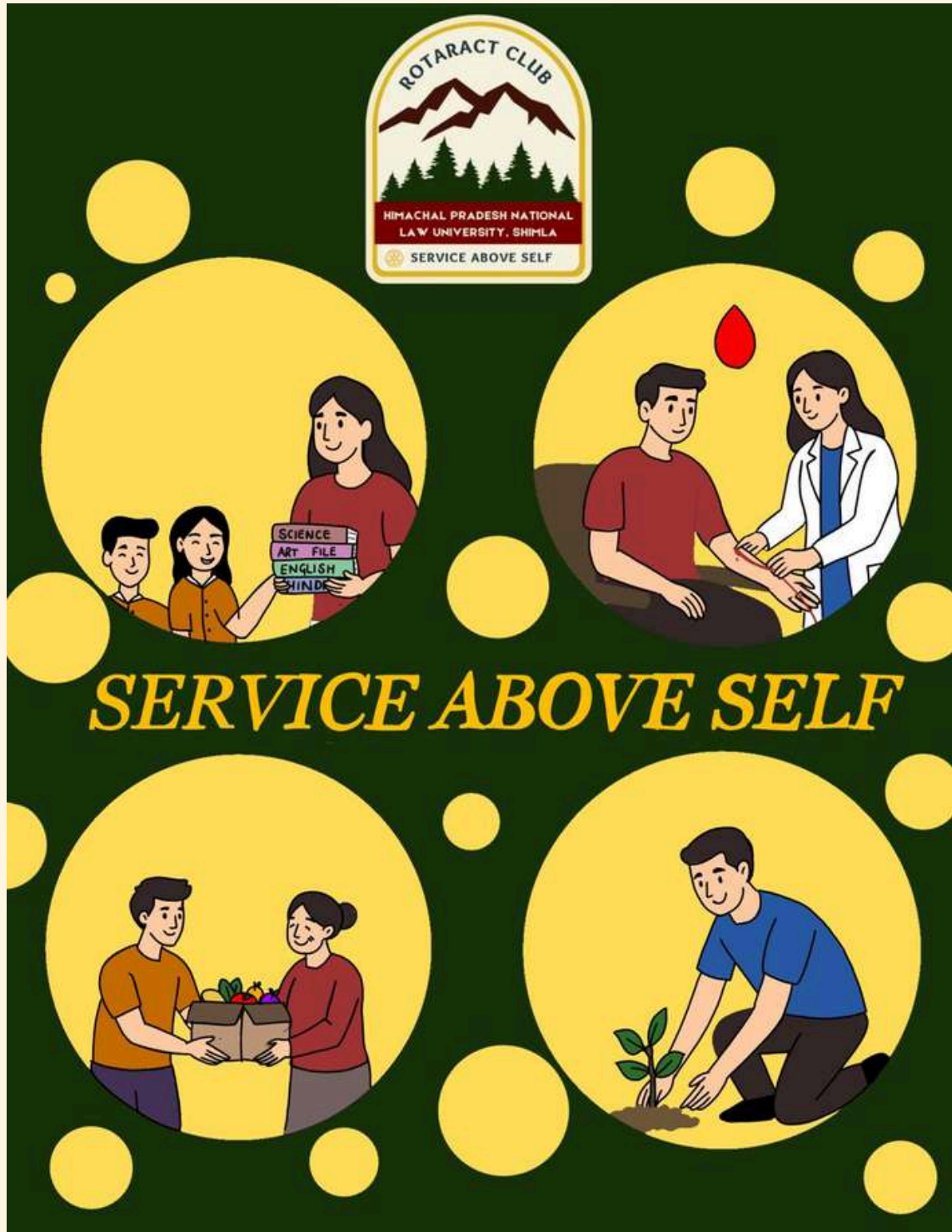
