  - (v) Objectives (This will include tentative objectives framed by scholar to be achieved by conducting the proposed research. These objectives will indicate the major aspects of the study to be undertaken including limitations.)
  - (vi) Research Question/Hypothesis (in case of non-doctrinal study, hypothesis is mandatory)
  - (vii) Significance of Study (justification for undertaking the proposed research is required, and the same should be framed as per the existing literature. The justification framed should indicate general as well as specific benefits likely to be achieved as a result of completion of the proposed research.)
  - (viii) Research Methodology
  - (ix) Plan of study/Chapterisation
  - (x) Bibliography

*Note 1:* As per the relevant rules, a relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed to those candidates belonging to SC/ST/Differently abled and other categories of candidates as per the UGC guidelines.

\*Note 2: Weightage to LL.M. percentage will be calculated in following manner: LL.M. Percentage 50-59= 07 Marks (for SC/ST/differently-abled and other categories); 55-59=07 Marks (For General); 60-64=09 Marks; 65-69=11; 70-74=13 Marks; 75-79=15 Marks; 80-84=17 Marks; 85-89=19 Marks; 90-94=21; 95 and above=23 Marks

The shortlisted candidates, on the basis of above criteria, shall be required to appear before the Research advisory committee (RAC) of the University to present and defend their research proposals. The RAC shall recommend the names of the candidates for provisional registrations under the Ph.D. Programme in Law. Merely being shortlisted for appearing before the RAC does not entitle a candidate for registration to the Ph. D. Programme in Law.
